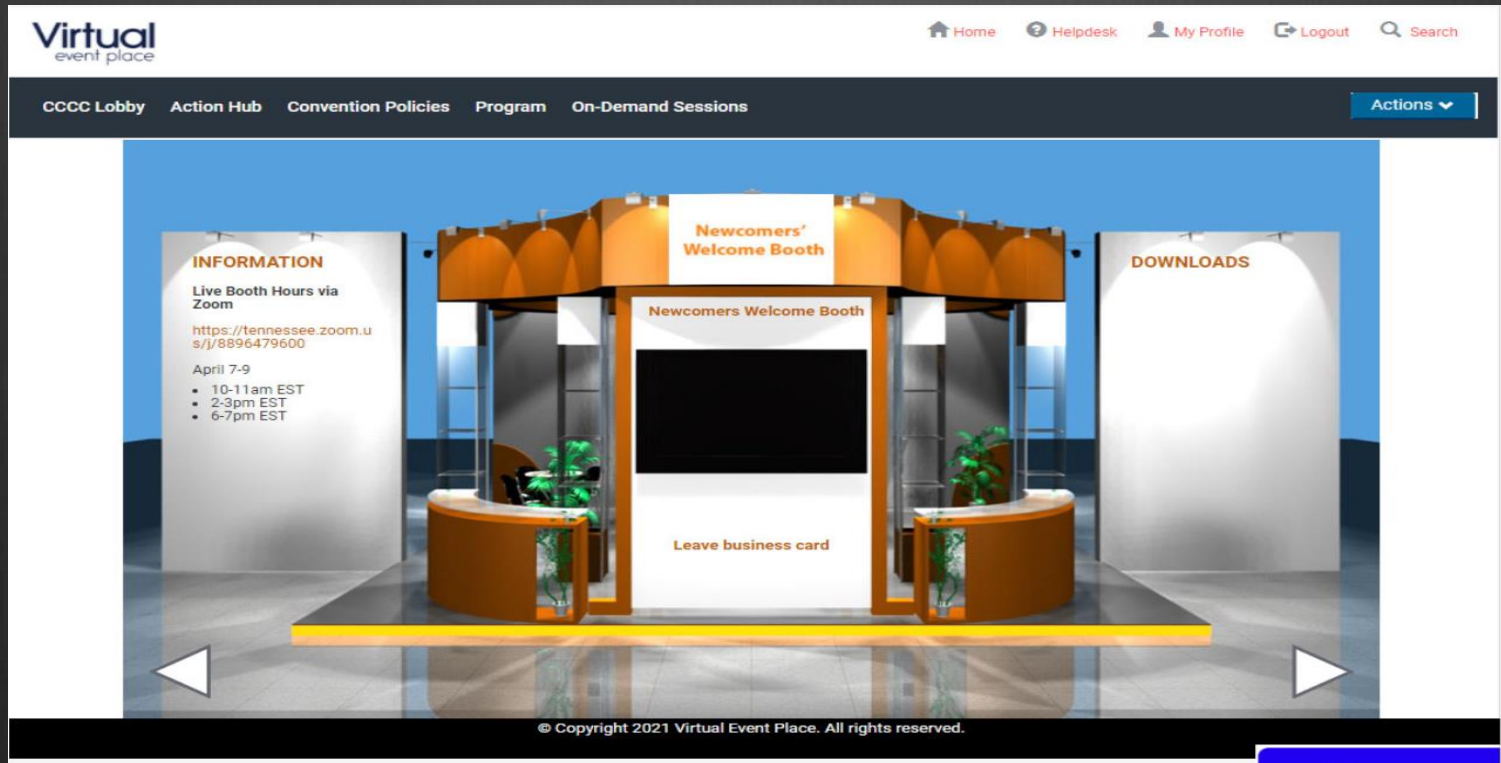

Tips for Managing

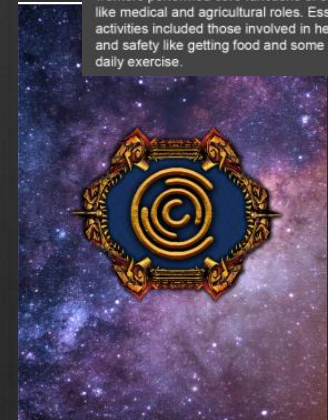
- 30-minute blocks between sessions. Step away from screen? Check out networking rooms? Stand and stretch?
